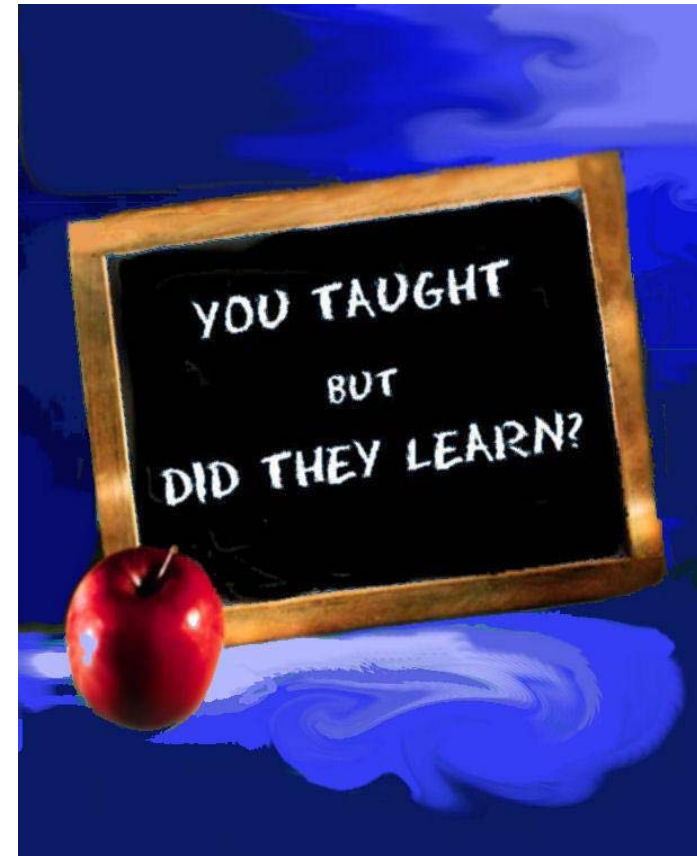

DOES PRO-OHIO WORK?

Assessments are tightly aligned to Ohio standards with correlations in the + .80 range or higher. In the 2007-08 school year

- Hamilton City Schools averaged 9.1 points higher in every OAT subject compared to the other 19 similar school districts*
- East Cleveland had a 46% gain over their similar schools districts*
- Goshen Local averaged 8.6 points higher in every OAT subject compared to other similar school districts*
- Mentor City Schools had a 24% increase over their similar school districts*

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

HOW DOES PRO-OHIO WORK?

- Baseline Data: At the start of the school year, teachers administer Form A paper test to discover what indicators to focus on.
- Formative Data: Teachers assign short-cycle web assessments.
- Summative Data: Teachers administer Form B in January to give students a second opportunity to practice with an OAT/OGT like pencil-and-paper test.
- Constructed-Response Items: Short-answer and extended-response items, formatted like the OAT, provided by *PRO*-Ohio along with a rubric teachers use to evaluate answers.
- PROgress Monitoring: Administrators and teachers view weekly progress reports for each student, subject, school and district.
